Prepping for Picture Day

- Find out when Picture Day is happening.

Every school is given flyers to post around campus with your school's picture date. This information is also typically available on the school calendar, website, or parent portals. You may also contact our office if you are unsure.

- Think about your hair and outfit choice.

Schedule a hair cut at least 10 days ahead of photo day. Most seniors choose to wear their hair down. Casual session outfits should reflect your personality, but also be school-appropriate. Large logos and bold patterns often take away from the main focus of the image - you!

- Booking a casual session? Feel free to bring props!

If you want to reflect your passion for music, sports, or other hobbies, think about what props you may want to bring. Its a great way to incorporate YOU!



On Picture Day:



Our photographers will provide all drapes and tuxes to wear for formal portraits; however, ladies, it is helpful if you come to your formal session with a camisole or strapless tank top. This will ensure that no straps are visible in your photos.

Glasses are okay to wear! Our photographers are trained on how to remove glasses glare.

Makeup should be applied as normal. If anything, a tad bit more powder may help reduce shine. All senior portraits include free retouching, so minor blemishes will be removed in purchased products and yearbook photos.

Be yourself! Don't worry about "perfect"! Our photographers will make you feel comfortable and you'll have a great time.
